Sue Williams was born in Cornwall and has for many years lived and worked in Cardiff. She has exhibited both in Wales and internationally; her work is represented in a number of public collections. Recently short-listed for the prestigious Artes Mundi 2, Wales International Visual Art Prize 2006, her work is currently exhibited alongside other artists selected at National Museum Cardiff.

Through her practice, Williams explores her passionate and fluid responses to the human condition and the complexities of subjectivity. More specifically, but not exclusively, she explores the construction of femininity in the west, within the broader context of a highly sophisticated consumerist and media-dominated culture, which shapes the way we live our lives and the relationships we form on a day to day basis. The resulting works seem to hold together many disparate thoughts and emotions. There is anger, humour, pathos and pleasure evident all at once. Her work raises pertinent questions about where we find ourselves now, about the personal and the political, the individual and the ideological.
