1. The 2021 Census data included above uses statistics from the following tables:

'Total households': Table TS041 - Number of Households

'Usual residents', 'In Households' and 'In Communal Establishments': Table TS001 - Number of usual residents in households and communal establishments

'Average Household Size' (derived value): Residents in households / Total households

2. Small area totals may not sum to the City & County of Swansea figure due to ONS Statistical Disclosure Control methodology.

In order to protect against disclosure of personal information, records have been swapped between different geographic areas and counts perturbed by small amounts. Small counts at the lowest geographies will be most affected.

3. These estimates reflect the SOA boundaries introduced for the publication of the 2021 Census results.

In Swansea, two former MSOAs were merged in 2021 (to create MSOA W02000198 - Swansea 032 in the above table).

4. The 'House of Commons Library MSOA Names' were published in October 2019 and aim to provide recognisable names for

MSOAs based on the towns, villages and neighbourhoods that they cover. The names aren't 'official' names for MSOAs,

but are intended to provide those using MSOA data with a resource to make that data easier to interpret and present.
