Notes:-

On the corner with Bohun Street, ground falls steeply to east.

1904-5. Designed by E Bruce Vaughan of Cardiff. Cost about £6000 (£4000 donated by Mr R Glyn Vivian).

Plan of undivide nave and chancel with vestries under, south aisle (north aisle never built), organ chamber and south porch. Perpendicular Gothic.

Twin gabled front from Manor Road, coursed rubble facings, Bath stone dressings, slate roofs with tiled crestings. Gable parapets with twin bellcote and weathervane to left over five-light traceried window; three-light window to south. Plinth and hoodmouldings. Buttressed side elevations, two-light windows, cross-gable with three-light window at east end (organ chamber). High east end with five-light window, polygonal staitower in angle,

Simple interior has five-bay arcade with polygonal piers, blocked north arch matching organ chamber arch to south. Ribbed and boarded ceilings with paired angel corbels at chancel entrance. Sedilia with foliage spandrels and paterae to hoodmould. Plain whitewashed walls with rere-arches to window splays, two-bay arcade facing south aisle. Wooden lectern and pulpit.
