

### Do I Qualify

You qualify for moped hire with Swansea Wheels 2 Work, if all of the below statements apply to you:

- 1. You live in the Swansea Council Local Authority area
- 2. You are 17 or over with your own full or provisional driving licence.
- 3. You have a job that you are at risk of losing or an offer of employment that you cannot accept due to transport difficulties.
- 4. You do not have your own transport.
- 5. It is too far (or dangerous) to walk or cycle to your employment and there is no public transport available at the times required and you are unable to lift share with family or friends or other employees or purchase your own transportation.
- 6. Have an account from which you can pay a direct debit i.e. bank or building society or credit union account.
- 7. The vehicle is to be used for transport to and from a place of employment. It may also be used for work which entails an element of travelling within the community e.g. community care work, but cannot be used for employment where use of a privately owned/rented vehicle is integral to the offer of employment and is expected to be used for that employment e.g. delivery work.
- 8. You can pay a deposit of £100, part refundable if the bike is returned in good condition.
- 9. You can afford weekly payments of £36
- 10. You have a secure place to park the vehicle, not on road (indoors, outbuilding or garage).
- 11. You have a guarantor if under 25 years of age.
- 12. Can cover insurance excess £350.
- 13. Have no motoring, or convictions pending within the last 5 years.

#### This hire cost is great value as it includes not only the moped but also:

- Comprehensive insurance
- Safety equipment
- Road tax
- L-plates
- Scheduled maintenance
- A lock to keep your moped safe when parked up
- Breakdown cover



## **Training**

Your safety is our priority and we want to ensure that you are trained and fully equipped to cope with your new life on the road on two wheels. Therefore all clients must complete Compulsory Basic Training (CBT) unless they hold a current CBT or motorcycle certificate.

As well as your training it is important that you have all the necessary safety gear required to protect you whilst on the road. You will be supplied with:

- A safety helmet
- Padded bike gloves
- High Visibility Jacket
- Bike Trousers
- Bike boots

Additional low cost safety equipment can be purchased by the client through the W2W programme

Wheels2Work operates a zero tolerance policy. We will not tolerate physical, verbal or any other type of abuse or threatening behaviour towards our staff. The Coordinator will be informed of such incidents and they may be reported to the Police. The perpetrator may receive a warning or be asked to leave the project. If this happens the scooter will be reclaimed immediately and the contract terminated. The scooters insurance will no longer be valid. Riding without insurance is a criminal offence for which the hirer shall be liable.

#### **City and County of Swansea Wheels to Work Guarantor**
