

Planning applications

Having your say at Swansea Council's Planning Committee

Listening to the people's views is an important part of Swansea Council's work. The Planning Committee welcome representations from local people about planning applications that affect them.

The Planning Committee decide the larger, complex or more controversial planning applications in the City.

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, Planning Committee meetings are now being held remotely.

Any representations submitted to date have been summarised in the Committee Report and taken into account in the preparation of the recommendation. These representations are available for Committee Members to view on the Council's Planning website. Should you have any additional representations to make, you should submit these in writing to planning@swansea.gov.uk **by midday the working day prior to the Committee.** These comments must be no more than 500 words and should be limited to new issues only. Comments will be made available to Committee Members. The council will not consider any offensive or potentially libellous comments.

Anybody who has previously commented on the application has the right to make a statement to Committee, subject to advance notice being given by midday the working day prior to the Committee. Any such verbal presentation would be limited to 5 minutes in total so you may need to liaise with other speakers to arrange timings.
